*PALM/PASSION LITURGY

CHOIR: The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all.

CONGREGATION: And also with you.

CHOIR: This is Palm Sunday-the day we remember Jesus' entry into Jerusalem.

CONGREGATION: This is also Passion Sunday—the day we recall that his socalled triumph was short-lived.

CHOIR: On Palm Sunday crowds cheered him and waved palm branches.

CONGREGATION: Before the week was over, many of the same people had rejected him, or simply gone back to what for them was normal.

CHOIR: "Hosanna to the Son of David. Blessed is He who comes as King in the Name of the Lord." So they called out on Sunday.

CONGREGATION: "Crucify him! We have no king but Caesar!" was their chant on Friday; and "if you are the Son of God, come down from your cross."

CHOIR: When he dismounted on Sunday, he went to the Temple.

CONGREGATION: When they were done torturing him on Friday, he was nailed to his cross.

ALL: It was for us and for our salvation that he went to Jerusalem.
