

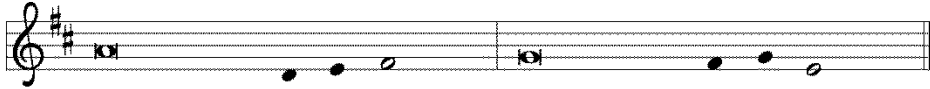


**PSALM – Psalm 69:7-10, 16-18**
