# Current Dedicated Account Balances

Air Conditioning Memorial: \$6,526.00; **Capital Improvement** Fund: \$28,288.83; **Education Memorial:** \$1,224.04; Gifts/Memorials (Undesignated): \$8,539.64; Portico Entrance Memorial: \$3,500.00; Sound System Memorial: \$306.00; **Fund for Missions** \$5.772.39: Cross Lutheran Investment Fund



Our financial condition for March shows a very strong position. Some of our members have paid their entire annual pledge in February so our year to date offerings are well above the anticipated amount. We have a very strong year to date net income of \$18,542. This compares to the budgeted loss of (\$2,435). We also received a gift from the Martin/Olson Trust in March which helped increase our other income to over \$3,000 above year to date budgeted other income. Expenses remain under budget which also plays a part in our net income. The unrealized gain or loss for March was \$2,269. We need to remember that each month we are recording the unrealized gain or loss from our CLIF and we are moving \$3,317.50 from savings to checking. These figures are included in our net income.

The March market value of the Cross Lutheran Investment Fund (CLIF) was \$112,551.26. The Board of Stewardship has decided to receive the quarterly disbursements from the CLIF and have them deposited into our savings account to use for community market expenses. Our first quarter distribution payment was \$1,083.30 and has been recorded in our dedicated accounts. We will not increase the amount of the CLIF but keep the disbursements separate as they are not being reinvested.
