Ben Kyle is one of my favorite local singer/songwriters. I first experienced his music in 2009 while attending Mercy Seat, which was a newer church plant in Northeast Minneapolis. One of the defining characteristics of Mercy Seat was their commitment to commissioning new liturgies from a wide range of musical artists and styles. Over the years, this little community helped launch jazz liturgies, folk liturgies, rock liturgies, and more. One of the thing that truly differentiated *Mercy Seat* liturgies is that they emerged from a wide range of artists — not all with Lutheran backgrounds — who were given the support and freedom to wrestle with their own questions of faith and express them through their own musical styles and gifts. They all followed the standard liturgical order — gather, word, meal, send — and usually included the requisite parts we are so familiar with: the Kyrie, Gloria, Alleluia, Sanctus, Agnus Dei, etc. For me, and for many who were a part of Mercy Seat, there was a sense of deep community and intimacy with the liturgy as we sang these songs of hope, and praise, and commitment.

Musically, it was pure and unadorned yet stunningly rich. A quiet guitar strummed simply, unpretentious piano notes and occasional chords, offset by soft vocals and poignant harmonies. It was like being carried along in a cloud, which let the words ring out even more clearly and true.

One of my favorite pieces is *Thank You*, a simple song of thanksgiving which follows holy communion:

Thank you for the way you make the showers fall, like a blanket on the valley when the flowers call Thank you for creating and sustaining it all Thank you from my heart, thank you from my heart.

Thank you for the way you make the music play
In between the quiet on a beautiful day
Thank you for the meaning in the things we say
Thank you from my heart, thank you from my heart
Let there be light, let there be love, let there be space
Let all the water flow together through the ether
and gather in a beautiful place

Let there be earth, let there be sea, let there be sky Let all the water flow together through the ether and gather over you and I

As we journey together into November, we are also taking time both in the church and in culture to give thanks for the big and little things, the visible and hidden things, things known and even unknown.

September 30, 2023 **Statement of Activities** 



September was another month where we saw a net loss, which was projected for this year. Our YTD actual figures still show us in a very strong position compared to the budget. September budgeted YTD loss was \$13,012.46 with a positive YTD income of \$9,908.46. This due to several items: We had some members who paid their entire pledge for the year early; rental income from the other congregations is \$14,448 over budget ,and we still continue to release 2022 undesignated surplus funds, of which, through September, \$27,636 have been released from savings to checking. We have added a line to record our unrealized gain or loss from the ELCA Foundation Investment. We have named this account the Cross Lutheran Investment Fund (CLIF) and it is where our Fund for Missions monies have been invested. So for September, we have an unrealized gain of \$1,013. We are able to withdraw funds from this account when needed. We will be paying for the next Community Markets with funds left in the Fund for Missions account. This will deplete the account so we will have to consider drawing funds from CLIF when more funds are needed for Community Markets. We used some of the funds in the Air Conditioning Memorial to purchase 6 window air conditioners for the offices and coffee room.

Hopefully you received your 2024 pledge letter and statement of intent for \$100,000 coss Lutheran Churcheekly offerings, as well as the capital improvement fund. Included with the letter is your 3rd quarter giving statement. Please let Carol know if there are any Statement of Activities ncies. Please return pledge card by November 19th. They are vital to our budget process.






