My, how Summer has flown. Or at least that's the way it feels to me. The past few months have been a blur of youth trips, hot days, dry grass, hazy skies and more. And, now, kids and teachers are heading back to school, football is back on the air, and steady rhythm of Fall weeks is just around the corner.

On Sunday, September 10, we'll begin the year of Mark in the narrative lectionary. And I sense that Mark's approach to the Good News of Jesus Christ offers an appropriate and timely model for this congregation in the coming year.

Matthew's Gospel begins with a comprehensive genealogy linking the Christ Child to the line of King David and God's covenantal promise to the people of Israel. Luke opens with an account of Jesus' holy conception and ties to the fulfillment of God's promises. John places Jesus at the beginning of all time —

Confirmation: The confirmation class is planning to attend the National ELCA Youth Gathering next summer in New Orleans. We will be joining youth from other synod congregations and in order to make the trip as reasonably priced as possible, have to commit by October 1. 
