It's also a big change, for it signals our affirmation that each of them are invited to assume full adult membership in the congregation, with the right to vote on important matters and contribute in significant ways.

As part of our final preparation for Confirmation, we'll be reviewing some of the lessons learned from the ELCA Youth Gathering this summer during education. I sincerely invite all of you to join us on October 6 and October 20 at 11 am to wonder and learn together. It is one way you can affirm their journey in the process.

Then please join us on Sunday, October 27 as we celebrate Confirmation Sunday during worship at 9:30 am. There will be further opportunity to celebrate and affirm this time of change immediately after.

**In The News:** Our Cross confirmation youth were mentioned recently in an article on the Saint Paul Area Synod Website. Here's an excerpt:

"Many of our congregations are thrilled to send high school youth to the ELCA Youth Gathering, held every three years around the U.S. But the logistics and planning for such a trip can be overwhelming, especially in smaller congregations that rely on volunteers. For the 2024 ELCA Youth Gathering that was just held in July, five congregations from our synod's City Conference combined resources and shared the burden of the logistical planning.

Traveling together were Christ on Capitol Hill, Gloria Dei, Immanuel and Pilgrim (all located in St. Paul), along with Cross (Maplewood). This partnership allowed for participation from congregations where planning alone might have prevented attendance...

...This year's Gathering wasn't the first time this group of City Conference congregations banded together. Several years ago, several of them started a cooperative confirmation program called "Deep Dive." Over the years, confirmation students and adults from each of the congregations have gathered monthly throughout the school year for learning, service and fellowship events. In the summer of 2023, a

group from the Deep Dive consortium traveled to Memphis, Tenn., for a service-learning trip. And many of the high school students who had been in Deep Dive together traveled together to New Orleans this summer.

## Current Dedicated Account Balances

Air Conditioning Memorial: \$5,000.00; Capital Improvement Fund: \$27,814.83; **Education Memorial:** \$1,224.04; Gifts/Memorials (Undesignated): \$8,539.64; Sound System Memorial: \$306.00; **Fund for Missions** \$14,461.45; Cross Lutheran Investment Fund (CLIF): \$\$114,666.60.



Our August report shows that Year to Date (YTD) giving is now even with the budgeted amount for 8 months. We've received more income than projected and have moved over \$26,000 from our savings account to our checking from the 2023 budget surplus. Our YTD total income is \$14,509 over budget. We should remember that each month we are recording the unrealized gain or loss of our CLIF and we are moving \$3,317.50 from savings to checking. These figures are included in net income. Our Boards continue to operate under budget which makes our YTD expenses for 8 months \$15,869 lower than budget. The resulting YTD end of summer income is \$12,573, which has not happened for many years.

We deposit quarterly distributions from CLIF into our savings account and these funds are available to help fund Community Markets. The total amount of quarterly distributions is \$2,166.60. We'll receive another distribution in September. We also had significant contributions to the Fund for Missions and CLIF, which is reflected in the balances below.

We thank everyone for your continued support of our Cross Lutheran family and our ministries at John Glenn Middle School, Feed My Starving Children, The Shores of Lake Phalen and others. Always, at Cross Lutheran, if there is a need, we do what we can and are called to do to help that need. THANK YOU!

Our September Community Market at John Glenn Middle School was yet another great event. If numbers hold, we have another great year ahead. In 2023, the September market served 87 households and we served 80 plus households every month throughout the school year.

#### September 25 Statistics:

93 households

407 Total Persons

260 Kids (Age 0-17 with at least 93 John Glenn students)

189 Adults (Age 18-64)

21 Seniors (65+)

34 Families

Several of the households we served consisted of seven or more persons, with one family of 13. We anticipate that larger families will continue to join us for the market.

6,452 pounds of food with 4,166 pounds from fresh & frozen.
