One of the often overlooked gifts that Martin Luther gave to the church are his hymns. Of course, most of us know *A Mighty Fortress*, a beautifully soaring sung sermon to the triumph of God through Jesus the Christ and the Holy Spirit. In fact, Luther composed dozens upon dozens of hymn tunes, but he also wrote hundreds of hymns over the years, many which have been translated into English, Swedish, Norwegian, Slovak, Polish, Spanish, Portuguese, Tagalog, Swahili, and others.

Our present hymnbook, *Evangelical Lutheran Worship*, contains fifteen of Luther's hymn texts. One of them—*Savior of the Nations, Come* (ELW263)—is an Advent hymn which we will sing at some point in worship this month. The fifth verse is particularly lovely:

Now your manger shining bright, hallows night with newborn light. Night cannot this light subdue; let our faith shine ever new.

It is a lovely reminder that despite shorter days and longer nights, and the creeping darkness which seems to be infecting the entire world, the light of God's love continues to shine. And the darkness will not overcome it. Let us together seek the light this Advent season.

Using our new financial report - here are the highlights for October:


- 1. Actual income is a net loss of (\$2, 520.29) before we include any unrealized gain or loss from the CLIF.
- 2. Including the unrealized gain improves the loss to only (\$806.56).
- 3. Our Year to Date (YTD) numbers are on track with the budgeted amount through October with the exception of income because our expenses are so much lower than we budgeted.
- 4. Remember that we rely on our rental income and the funds being moved from savings to checking to help us with our operational needs - bills and salaries.

As we begin our budgeting process, we have asked the Boards to be very diligent in making their projections for 2026.

We are very grateful to everyone who made donations to Lutheran World Relief. We were amazed to be able to send them a check for \$40,460.00! THANK YOU!!


